

The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's Cincinnati/NKY Light The Night Walk
Yeatman's Cove, Downtown Riverfront

At the Registration/Check In Area: Walkers drop off any donations and pick up t-shirt and lantern tickets, and Champion for Cures wristbands for food. All registered participants will receive a lantern. Participants who have raised \$100 will receive a t-shirt and their wristband for food. We encourage team captains to check in for their entire team. **If you have already turned in all of your team's funds, and picked up your t-shirts/lanterns, then you do not have to wait in line at Check In. Walkers, please check with your team captain to see if they have picked up your t-shirt and lantern already!**

At the Walk Welcome Area/Leis Of Light: Walkers will be greeted with a blinking "lei", courtesy of our "Leis of Light Sponsor", Performance Automotive Network (while supplies last).

At the Lantern Tent Area: Eligible fundraisers can bring their lantern ticket and pick up their lantern here.

At the T-shirt Tent Area: Eligible fundraisers may redeem their t-shirt tickets for 2017 Light the Night shirts here. Sizes available are **Small-XXXL**. There are no child sizes. Due to more funds being raised than originally anticipated, please note that it's possible we will run out of shirts. If we do, the volunteer will ask for your name, email, and shirt size and you will be able to pick them up in our office post-walk. All Patients and Survivors may pick up their "Survivor" shirt here, regardless of fundraising amount.

At the Mission Tent Area: Survivors and Patients may pick up their White Lantern.

At the OHC Tent Area: Survivors and Patients may pick up their superhero cape at the OHC Tent (right next to the Mission Tent).

At the Drops of Hope and Light Tent: Sponsored by Hoxworth Blood Center, at this tent, participants can write a message or name on a blood drop and hang it up on a large banner. You can also get a delicious cookie!

At the Remembrance Pavilion: If you are walking in memory of someone, visit the Remembrance Pavilion to pin up a picture (note-**please bring your own picture** as we will not be printing them ahead of time this year), write a name or message on a blood drop, light a candle, and reflect. This is a **new area** this year and features an illuminated, gold dome.

Photo Booth: Get your picture taken at the TapSnap Photo Booth, sponsored by PEP Promotions! Pictures will be printed on the spot.

Team Photo Area: Gather your team and head to the stage area from 5:30 to 7:00 to have your team's photo taken. Look for the large ProLink Staffing Step & Repeat banner on the stage.

At the Kids Zone Area: Take part in kid's crafts, face painting, and other fun activities.

At the VIP Area: Fundraisers (and one guest) who are members of the Bright Lights Club (**raising \$1000 or more by 10-17**) may enjoy special food provided by Longhorn Steakhouse and Great American Cookie Company, and alcoholic beverages provided by Stagnero Distributing (must be consumed in the VIP tent and must be 21). Bright Lights Club participants can also pick up their exclusive "top fundraiser" **Scarf** in the Bright Lights Tent.

At the Champion For Cures Food Zone Area: Individuals wearing a **Champion for Cures** wristband may enjoy food and drinks compliments of our many in-kind donors!

General Food Zone Area: **Non-Champions For Cures** will have access to pizza, hotdogs, and snacks.

Walk Route: The Walk Route will leave from Yeatman's Cove, cross the Taylor Southgate Bridge, go through Newport on the Levee, and come back over the Purple People Bridge. Please note that the Purple People Bridge will be closed and walkers must walk on Pagan's Path, which is the sidewalk along the bridge. This may cause some backlog in Newport on the Levee as walkers are getting on the sidewalk to come back to Yeatman's Cove.

Following the walk: Enjoy the Fireworks Show, music, sweet treats and a great feeling of helping to cure cancer!
